Ever been out in the middle of nowhere with your cellphone or iPod and had the battery die on you only to be left desperately needing a phone or the latest fix of your favourite Podcast? Here's the solution!

Cellboost boasts power on the go for all brands of mobile phone and even iPods at fairly reasonable prices for such last-resort emergency devices. Cellboost is basically just a portable, disposable battery which you can plug into your mobile phone or iPod and recharge on the go.

"Cellboost is a disposable battery/charger that provides instant talk-time or music in addition to charging the battery. The pocket-sized accessory, inserted into a phone or iPod standard battery charger socket, restores power to a dead or dying unit within seconds, without needing mains power or changing batteries"

Cellboost for mobile phones offers 1 hour of talk-time minimum, which is more than enough for a lengthy conversation and certainly plenty for emergency phone calls, in addition it offers 60 hours of standby time which we assume is affected by how much talking you do and can be preserved simply by turning your phone off... it is possible, you know!



Cellboost for iPod offers a fairly hefty 8 hours of *music* playback time minimum, and claims even more on newer iPod models due to better battery usage efficiency.
